Extra consideration is given to applicants who will be attending a United Methodist school. **The application has changed, so read all parts carefully!**

It is the goal of this committee to make the application process as simple and easy as possible. Please read the application very carefully and provide all the requested information. **ALL SECTIONS OF THE APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED.** If any of these elements are not provided, your application will be considered **INCOMPLETE** and, therefore, **NOT ELIGIBLE** for a scholarship award.

Part 1 requires general information about yourself and your current academic situation. To be complete, your transcript **MUST** include the Spring 2019 semester. Official and unofficial transcripts will be accepted. Part 2 asks for personal information that you think is important for the committee to consider in evaluating your application. Part 3 requests a list, just a list, of your activities in your church and community. Part 4 asks you to respond to three prompts as related to the mission of BSUMC. Please thoughtfully consider your responses as the Scholarship Committee looks forward to reading your replies. Part 5, the Scholarship Application Checklist, is designed for your use and need not be included with your submission. Finally, please consider typing your application. If you are unable to type, please print neatly.

Early Applications (Intended for students attending United Methodist colleges/universities participating in the Dollars for Scholars program through UMHEF.) will be reviewed during the month of February. Your completed *early application* **MUST BE IN THE CHURCH OFFICE NO LATER THAN 4 P.M. ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2019.**

All other applications will be reviewed during the month of June. Your completed application **MUST BE IN THE CHURCH OFFICE NO LATER THAN 4 P.M. ON FRIDAY, MAY 31, 2019.** All applications received after this deadline will not be considered. Applicants will be notified of the awards by mail.
